Hi,

Just a run down on things that may be of interest for you in the Mokau

On the 28/08/2014 a vehicle stolen from Wellington was used to steal petrol from the Junction Service Station. Five people were arrested in the Awakino Gorge and put before the court.

On the 29/08/2014 an attempt was made to steal a digger in the Ahititi area.

On the 3rd at about 6:00 pm an unmarked plain white van travelling north through the Gorge threw a half full Fanta bottle at the windscreen of an on-coming truck. Some maths - the truck was travelling at about 85 km/h, the van was travelling at least 80 km/h, this equals the bottle hitting the windscreen at = 165 km/h. The driver of the truck was lucky it hit the stone guard first. Awaiting forensic results which may help determine who it was.

Overnight on Sat the 20th someone has entered a house Awakino Heads Road and stolen a king and queen bed.

If you are able to provide any information in regards to the above incidents, let me know, it can be confidential. Also it is coming into the cannabis season again, if it doesn't look right it probably isn't, let me know, again, it can be confidential.

Crashes:

On the 12/08/2014 at about 8:40 pm a vehicle crash occurred on SH 3, 1 km north of Mokau involving just the one vehicle which crashed into a tree after swerving, no one was hurt. On the 13/09/2014 at about 4.40 am a vehicle crash occurred on SH 3 Tongaporutu, a vehicle lost control on a corner in the wet, sliding down the bank and resting on some bushes, 2 meters from the river. Only the one vehicle involved and no one was hurt.

MOKAU COAL SUPPLIES AGAIN RAISED

Possibilities of the development of the Mokau coalfield were again raised in Parliament when Mr W.J. Broadfoot (Opposition, Waitomo) addressed a question to the Minister of Works, the Hon. R Semple when he asked if the minister's attention had been drawn to an article in The New Zealand Electrician by J.A. Piggot recommending the Mokau coalfield as a generating source of electricity and if the minister would investigate the matter with a view to action. Later Mr Broadfoot commented that 80% of electricity in the United States came from coal or oil fuel and only 20% from water power.

TDN 1/8/1949 SLOW MOVING SLIP

A slow moving slip of rain-soaked clay partially covered the New Plymouth—Auckland highway at the end of the new road formation about four miles north of Urenui yesterday. When the last report of the slip was received last night it was about eight feet high and was still forming across the roadway. One way vehicular traffic was still able to travel through safely.
