Management Submission to 2024-2034 Long Term Plan on Roading Maintenance Contract Costs

The Roading Maintenance Contract went out for tender for implementation 1 July 2024.

Staff have been working with the preferred tenderer to align the tender bid with Council's proposed roading budget.

At the time Long Term Plan submissions closed the preferred tenderer's bid was still higher than the amount included in the proposed Long Term Plan budget.

Options being considered by staff are:

- 1. Changes to the level of service contracted to the preferred tenderer for the roading maintenance contract to align with the proposed budget OR
- 2. Increasing the budgeted cost for the roading maintenance budget in the Long Term Plan. This will require increased funding from New Zealand Transport Agency of 75% of the subsidised programme with 25% coming from roading rates and 100% of the unsubsidised roading programme changes coming from roading rates.
- 3. A combination of the above.
